Warm Diseases - The 4 Levels



Wen Bin in Chinese

• **Definition:** diseases that are due to Wind-Heat invasion affecting the 4 Levels.

The 4 Levels (in order from most surface to deepest) are:
Wei level (superficial, skin & muscles), Qi level (LU ST LI),
Ying level (Nutritive Qi) & Flood level (ET, EC). With each
tevel Le pulce and penetrate the worse the disease gets.

- Western common disorders: pandemic (Avian flu, H1N1, Covid-19), epidemic febrile diseases, preumonia, bronchitis, dysentery, and meningitis.
- Treatment options: bleeding ear apex, cupping DU 14.



Xiao Chuan in Chinese

- **Definition:** breathlessness, congestion and/or constriction in the chest area (with inspiration difficulty). It may be acute or chronic, and often occurs in the background of other chronic disorders.
- Characteristics: episodic obstructive lung disorder with randowing of the large & small airways. Que to spasm of the shoot hand class of the orange. Also says to much production.
- Symptoms. wheezing; dyspnea; tight chest; after attacks the patient may cough profuse phlegm
 - (no cheese , ice cream , sugars or high saturated fatty foods). Ear (LU, KD).

- **Definition:** difficulty passing stools, and/or prolonged intervals between bowel movements. Daily bowel movement is essential for health.
- Causes: emotions, stress, diet, drugs illness , tck Sexencis.

- Treatment options: ear (LI, LV, Shen Men), diet (fibre, hydration, lubrication), lifestyle (exercising), and abdominal massage.

Neurological Disorders - Symptoms



This chapter includes disorders/symptoms affecting the **central nervous system**. However, some are also **sometimes qualified as autoimmune** (like chronic fatigue syndrome).

It's important to always **look at the root cause** - which often can be emotional trauma, weak Essence or long standing stress - and address it.

Most of these symptoms/disorders are **not easy to fix** and can take a while before we see any improvement. However, patients should see some changes (even small ones) within 2 to 3 sessions of acupuncture, and even faster when combined with lifestyle changes and herbal formulas.

Er Ming in Chinese

- **Definition:** ear ringing, referring to any buzzing sound in one or both ears. **Causes**: Kidney Essence declining, nathogens, and emotions.
- Western common disorders: wex buildap, cute Atitis perfera ed Iram, Meniere' disease tur ours, drag us (carnabis, allenol, tabacco, quinine, etc), high blood pressure, anemia, altitude sickness, aneurysm
- Treatment options: ear (LV, GB, Ear, Inner Ear).

Pain Disorders - Symptoms



This chapter is probably going to be your favourite, because in general, we see a **lot of patients with pain issues.**

This is when you can use all the TCM tools to help each patient with pain (acute or chronic). I often do Tui Na, electro stimulation, moxa and/or cupping alongside my needling.

When it comes to **acute pain** disorders/symptoms, it's recommended to treat as soon as possible (the same day would be fantastic!).

The longer we wait, the slower the response.




Lower Back Pain

- **Definition:** lower back pain encompassing pain from T 12 to S 4
- Causest pathogens, weak TCM Kidney, trauma, emotions.
- Western common disorders: I uney stones, pelvicenfla new tronese at ca, filtromyalçia, iscardiat on, osterarthrais praecological problems, kidney infection, rheumatoid arthritis...
- Treatment options: cupping, ear (KD, LV, Lumbar), and/or electro acupuncture on the area affected.

Mental Disorders



According to TCM classics, emotions are responsible for 70% of chronic disorders (including physical issues). Emotional trauma and long standing emotional stress may lead to a mental disorder.

Many patients may come to see an acupuncturist for fertility support, but they also suffer from years of anxiety. It is very important to **address the emotional aspect, in order to have any success** with the physical problem.

In TCM, invisible **Phlegm affects the brain** and can create mental health issues. In my practice I **always needle ST 40** (the best AcuPoint for any kind of Phlegm) on patients who have any mental health disorder.

Women's Disorders



This is the biggest chapter in this book, as I have included the most common disorders/symptoms affecting the **woman's reproductive system**, including menses issues, premenstrual syndrome, pregnancy and menopause.

According to TCM foundation, **women are more Yin** and men are more Yang. Women are affected more by TCM Blood patterns, therefore we **use points from the Spleen, Liver, Heart and Kidney meridians** a lot more. Because the 8 Extraordinary Vessels circulate Essence, we often use their points as well to balance reproductive hormones.

If you're stuck and can't figure out the TCM diagnosis for a female patient, here's a **basic acupuncture point combination** that will lead to great results:

LU 7 (R), KD 6 (L), PC 6 (L), SP 4 (R)



Early Period

Acne



- **Definition:** chronic skin condition affecting mostly teenagers, although it affects people of all ages. Includes pimples, blackheads & whiteheads forming around hair follicles, which may contain pus and be painful. Located mostly on the face, upper back or chest. Depending on its severity, across an exartic skin.
- CM causes: diet, stress, drugs, medication side effects, hormonal changes (pregnancy, menses, etc).
- **Treatment options:** Jin Huang Cao paste (apply to skin and let it dry out overnight). Addressing diet is key: avoid all processed foods , sugar and alcohol .
